PARTICIPANT PROFILE – INCLUSION CRITERIA:

Are you Lebanese and 18 years old or above? Do you currently live or have you lived in Lebanon?

- Have you been exposed to traumatic events from the official outbreak of the civil war (April 13th, 1975) until the explosion of August 4th, 2020?
- Would you like to explore the impact of these events on your mental health?
- Would you like to explore the feelings of insecurity and injustice of permanently living/having lived in a failing political-security and judicial environment?

OBJECTIVES OF THE RESEARCH PROJECT:

The overall objective of this project is to explore the impacts of potentially traumatic cumulative events related to living permanently in a failing political-security environment, as well as the impact of the lack of justice on the mental health of the Lebanese.
